1. Our Mission

2. Our Values

In our day-to-day operations, we are guided by the following principles:

 - promotion of responsible tourism;

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3. Responsible Equipment Rental

We believe that renting camping equipment is a more sustainable alternative than purchasing equipment that is only used occasionally.

For this reason, we ensure that all of our equipment is:

- regularly inspected;
- properly maintained;
- cleaned and prepared for reuse;
- used for as long as possible while maintaining high standards of safety and quality.

This approach helps reduce waste and lowers the demand for new materials.

4. Respect for the Natural Environment

We encourage our customers to enjoy Tenerife's natural areas responsibly.

Among other things, we recommend:

- leaving every place exactly as you found it;
- camping only in designated camping areas;
- never leaving waste in nature;
- respecting local flora and fauna;
- avoiding noise that may disturb other people or wildlife.

5. Protection of Natural Resources

We encourage the responsible use of available resources, particularly:

- water;
- energy;
- firewood (where its use is permitted);
- camping facilities and infrastructure.

Even small actions taken by each visitor can make a meaningful contribution to environmental protection.

6. Compliance with Regulations

Easy Camp Tenerife supports only legal forms of camping.

We encourage our customers to:

- obtain all required permits;
 - comply with campsite rules;
 - follow announcements and recommendations issued by the Cabildo de Tenerife;
 - respect temporary closures of natural areas;
 - observe all applicable fire restrictions.
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7. Customer Education

We believe that responsible tourism begins with knowledge.

For this reason, we provide our customers with information about:

- campsite regulations;
- staying safe during their trip;
- environmental protection;
- responsible behaviour in natural areas;
- good camping practices.

Our goal is not only to rent equipment but also to help our customers make informed and responsible decisions.

8. Cooperation with the Local Community

We respect local communities, applicable regulations and the institutions responsible for protecting Tenerife's natural environment.

Our business aims to support the sustainable development of tourism while promoting the island's attractions with respect for its unique character.
